



COVID-19 Safe system (B&B)

Keeping you safe and well at Brathay

What you can do:

- Following the social distancing rules at all times
- Only use the designated doors for access and egressing the buildings
- Open window prior to leaving your accommodation
- One person only within communal toilets, change vacant/ engaged sign when entering and leaving
- Clean your hands prior and after using the welfare facilities
- Clean hands prior to entering the buildings
- Open windows for additional ventilation when possible
- Leave your key in your room at the end of your stay
- If you need to talk to another guest, meet in a well ventilated area, ideally outside

What we are doing:

- Keys in rooms on arrival, reducing contact with others
- Cleaning stations throughout the building for sterilising items
- Hand sanitising stations throughout the buildings
- One-way systems for entering and exiting building where possible
- Hand sanitising stations prior to entering buildings
- Social distancing markers on floors
- Guidance and reference notes throughout the buildings
- Disinfect room with a fogging machine after each booking
- Welcome pack in rooms consisting of PPE

All these measures are practically possible, but some will cause a level of inconvenience and take some time to get used to. It is important to stress at this time they are necessary to save lives and prevent the virus from spreading.

The easing of social and economic lockdown measures following the COVID-19 outbreak is being supported by NHS Test and Trace. Brathay will assist this service by keeping a temporary record of our customers and visitors and assist NHS Test and Trace with requests for that data if needed. This could help contain clusters or outbreaks.
